### **Pupil Premium 2025-26**

For the financial year 2025-2026 it is estimated that North Islington Nursery School & Children's Centre will receive £7,410 Pupil Premium funding. The EYPP rate for 2025-26 has increased to £570 for each 3 and 4 year old who are entitled to 15 hours free education and who are eligible for free school meals. We are funded on a termly basis to account for any movement or change in eligibility.

#### **The school intends to use this funding to:**

Continue to employ an artist in residence for one day every fortnight for the Summer Term.

From the Autumn Term we plan to commission a HCPC registered Speech and Language Therapist for half a day per week at the cost of £6,825 per year.
